### Background to the post:

Step-by-Step is a dynamic local charity, based in Aldershot, which has over 15-years experience in progressing young people from homelessness and the problems associated with it. We provide accommodation and support to young people, mainly aged 16 -25 years. This is achieved through a number of services within Step by Step each with its own specific aims and objectives but within the overall mission of *"empowering homeless people and those facing adversity to achieve their full potential"*. We also promote widespread awareness of the issues involved amongst the local community.

### Purpose of Role:

Working as part of our dedicated team of community fundraising volunteers you will be responsible for presenting and communicating Step by Step's cause to schools and colleges. By way of a standard presentation, you will promote the work that Step by Step does and establish ways in which the school or college can help us continue this work specifically focussing on funding for the Youth Development Projects we provide.
