ROLE OVERVIEW

Step up and **Be the Hero** for local young people! As Lead/Chair of the Step by Step New Forest Community Heroes, you'll take the lead in rallying a dynamic team to support young people facing homelessness. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Leading the Charge:

- Steer meetings with energy and purpose, collaborating with the Secretary and Step by Step's Charity Champion.
- Set the agenda for meetings in partnership with the Secretary and Charity Champion.
- Keep the team focused and motivated on their mission to change lives.
- Encourage creativity and ownership of initiatives to make an impact.

Keeping Things on Track:

- o Ensure the team is working within agreed guidelines and policies.
- Be the driving force behind achieving community goals and fundraising targets, ensuring our mission stays on track and delivers impact.
- Regularly meet with and report to the Charity Champion to align efforts and receive ongoing support.

• Building Connections:

- Be the face of the team at community events and networking opportunities.
- Forge strong partnerships with local businesses and community groups.
- Advocate for young people and inspire others to join the mission.

Spreading the Word:

- o Oversee fundraising and awareness campaigns with enthusiasm.
- Help deliver exciting marketing campaigns with the charity team.
- Speak passionately to local groups and schools about the cause.



• Shaping the Future:

 As the first Community Heroes Hub, work with Step by Step to create the committee charter that will be rolled out to all future groups.
